

Sandwich Technology School 16 to 19 Tuition Funding 2021-2022

What is the 16 to 19 tuition fund?

The 16-19 tuition fund is available to the school to support particular groups of students who have had their learning disrupted by COVID-19 in Years 12 and 13.

How should the 16-19 tuition funding be used?

The funding is being provided to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, mathematics, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. The school will prioritise support for students who have not achieved a grade 4 in English and/or mathematics but funding permitting further consider whether any other targeted young people with a grade 4 also need catch up support.

How much funding did the school receive and what is/will it be used for?

The funding will be used to primarily provide small group tuition for students who have not yet achieved a grade 4 or above in English and/or mathematics or are from an economically disadvantaged background (as defined in the [government guidance](#)) and need catch up support. This support will not just be in English or mathematics but will also address gaps in other qualifications being studied. This tuition will be in addition to students' normal timetabled lessons and will be in small groups of up to 5 students.

Tuition support offered will be based on an individual needs assessment. The sessions will have clear learning goals that will address the gaps in student knowledge/skills and progress across the sessions will be monitored for effectiveness.
