

## Year 12 / 13 Assessments May 17<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup>

Your teachers will use the last two weeks of term to provide questions recently provided by the examination boards. This widens the amount and range of evidence used and enables you to complete papers that are longer than 50 minutes. Your answers will form part of the evidence used to decide your overall grade.

These are not exams but the highest standards of conduct are expected during these assessments so that all students can fully concentrate and do their best. The main rules are:

- Silence at all times during the assessment
- Do not attempt to distract or communicate with another student
- If you have a question, raise your hand and the member of staff will help you

Breaking these regulations could have an impact on your evidence and the grade your teacher is therefore able to award. For most of the assessments, you will follow your normal timetable with the same room and the same teacher. On some occasions, the member of staff who supervises your assessment may not be your usual teacher. This may apply when an assessment lasts longer than your timetabled lesson and a different teacher has to supervise the second half. This does not matter as it is not permitted for teachers to give answers or provide help during these assessments anyway.

All students who are eligible will have additional time provided, either in the classroom or in an alternative venue.

Your timetabled lessons will run as normal throughout the two weeks. When you don't have an assessment, lessons will focus on gathering additional evidence for the awarding of grades and preparation for the next stage of your education. You should not worry unduly about these assessments; your teachers have been collecting evidence since your return to school on March 9th. Teachers can also reflect on work completed in Year 12 and the early part of Year 13. However, doing well in these assessments will only improve the positive evidence base that your teachers will use.

All assessments are for Year 13 unless stated otherwise
