

## Home Learning FAQs

### **Where do I find my lessons?**

All lessons are on Google Drive. The link to your year group folder can be found here:

### **I don't know my school login details. How do I find them?**

Your username to access your school e-mail account is the year you started Y7 followed by your surname (up to 7 letters) and your first letter of your first name.

E.g. A Y11 student called Joe Bloggs would have the username: 16BLOGGSJ

A Y9 student called Tim Anonymous would have the username: 18ANONYMOT

Students will have chosen their own password. This is the same as the password they use to log on to a computer at school.

### **I don't have Microsoft Office on my home computer. Can I get this?**

### **How do I access the lessons on my Xbox?**

1. From your Xbox homepage select 'my games and apps' and select 'see all'.
2. Select 'apps'
3. Scroll through and select Microsoft Edge (blue square with a white 'e')
4. You are now on the internet and can use your controller to search and visit webpages as you normally would.
5. You can now either go Google drive directly (remember to sign in using your school email address and password) or access the pre-recorded lessons through the school website as you would do on any other device.
