To Parents/Carers who are Key Workers

I just wanted to give additional information to you as your child has been using the Key Worker Provision during the school closure. The main information you will need for school reopening has been sent to you via Mrs Savage's letter.

- 1) Key Worker Provision will remain open up to and including Friday 12 March.
- 2) Should you no longer need a place please can you let me know via email as soon as possible (or call into Reception if it's easier and they will pass on the details to me).
- 3) If you use the provision based on a shift pattern/childcare needs and you know what days your child will be in from 8 to 12 March, please could you email in advance to let me know.

(Points 2 and 3 above help me to staff the provision, but we also have a new set of parents who require spaces, due to their critical work opening again on 8 March, and I am currently full.)

- 4) There will be one remaining, optional PE session on Friday 5 March in the afternoon.
- 5) Students will be tested on Friday 5 March if in school (see Mrs Savage's letter for more details around consent).
- 6) We have not been made aware of any changes to the bus or train times, but we ask parents to be proactive in checking this for the route their child requires.
- 7) If you are a family who has also been given a loan laptop, this can be returned to Reception on your child's last day in Key Worker Provision OR on their first day back in full lessons.

Thank you for your support and we are looking forward to seeing all of the students back with us fully.
